As part of a Department of Defense (DoD) contract, data may be collected, created, transmitted, or received from or for the government. This includes Controlled Unclassified Information (CUI), which refers to sensitive, unclassified information, and Federal Contract Information (FCI), which is non-public information.

The [Cybersecurity Maturity Model Certification](#) (CMMC) program is designed to help protect both types of data that may be shared between the DoD and its contractors and subcontractors. The regulation became effective in late 2024 and is expected to appear in some DoD contracts and solicitations in 2025.

The CMMC program is intended to enforce compliance with cybersecurity requirements for systems that handle CUI and FCI, aligning with the DoD's information security standards for the defense industrial base. Under the CMMC rule, members of the defense industrial base must adopt a range of cybersecurity controls based on the specific type and sensitivity of the information they process.

Compliance with CMMC will be mandatory for DoD contract awards, with a few limited exceptions.
